Hopefully you got your limbs out and they have all been picked up as we have finished up our chipping for this fall. Starting next week you will see the leaf collection system out making its rounds so start piling those leaves out near the roads edge. Our leaf collection campaign will most likely run until mid December possibly later depending on weather and conditions. You will receive several notices via the newsletter.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR LEAF PICK UP:

1. All leaves must be within 4' of the roads edge.
2. Leaves must be placed in front of your house. If leaves are to be placed on vacant lot written permission from lot owner must be brought to the attention of Property Manager to guarantee pickup.
3. Keep leaves away from roadside structures i.e. mailboxes, fire hydrants, etc.
4. Do not pile leaves in ditches or place near culverts, storm drains, or anywhere water drainage may be disrupted.
